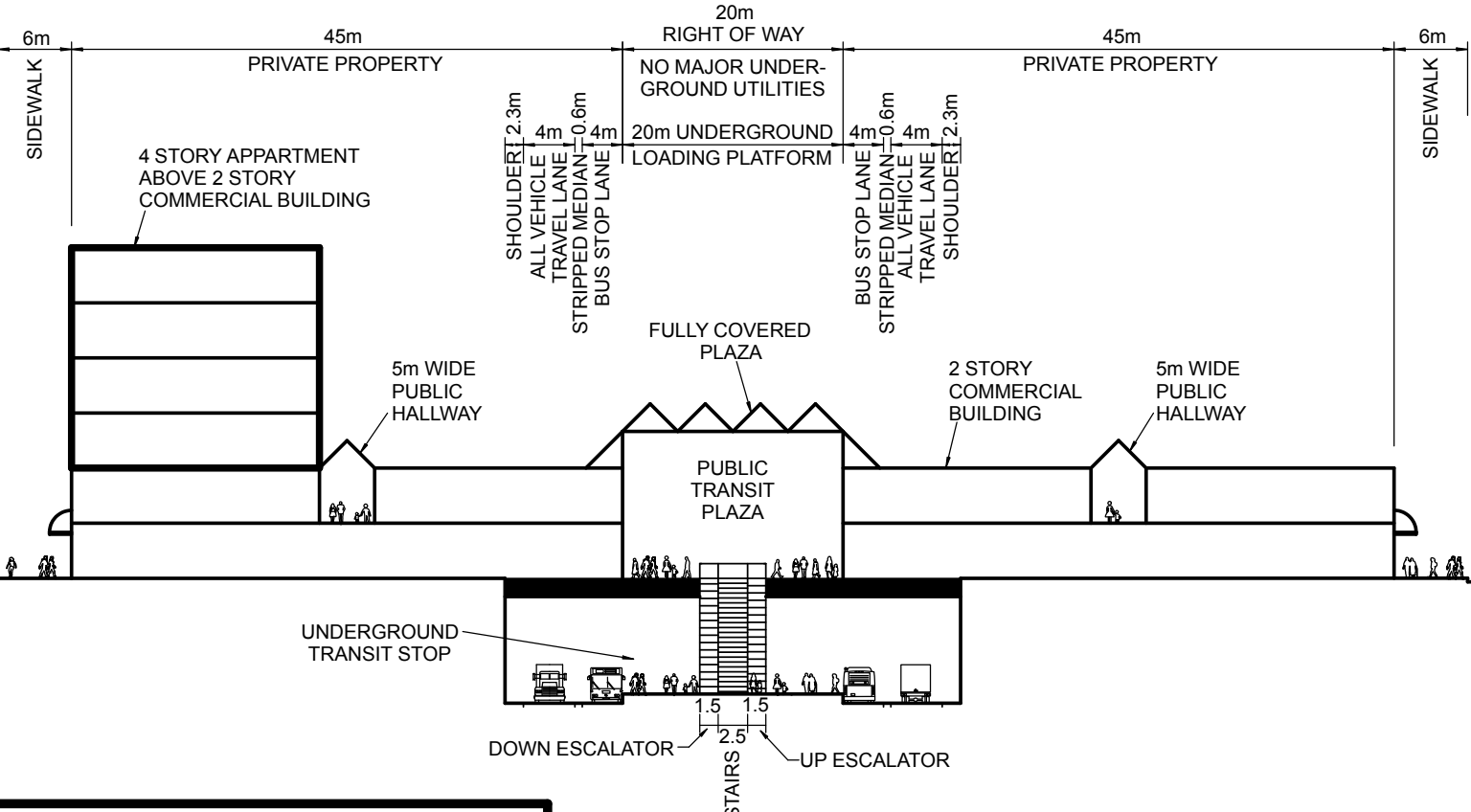
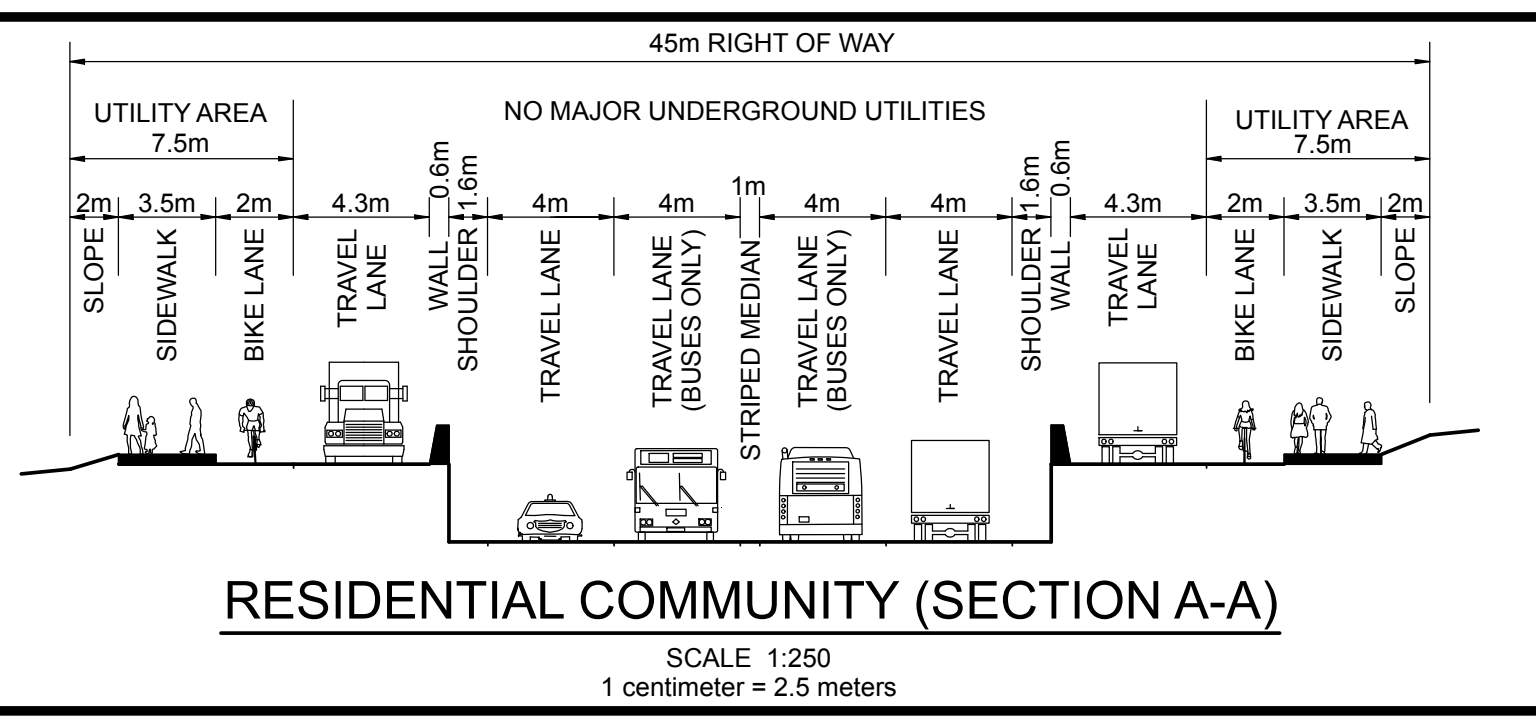

- Natural Park (Forest)
- Playing Fields and Garden Plots
- Orchards
- Deciduous trees, Evergreen trees, Shrubs and Hedges
- Single Family Dwelling (2 stories)
- Row Houses (2 stories)
- Apartment Building (3 stories)
- Right of way or property lines
- Hiking trails
- Underground transit stop and through traffic roadway
- Interior building truck loading docks and second story 4.5m wide public hallways
- Retaining wall or tunnel entrance

- RCTT Residential Community Transit Terminal (below public plaza)

Note: Throughout most of this drawing the landscaping is shown overly simplified. However, within the Garden Village residential community there are two areas where landscaping is shown in greater detail - an apartment complex in the northeast quadrant and another in the southwest quadrant.

Garden Village facts:
Garden Village is community number C1, the first community in transit loop C.
Area - 535 meters on each side or 28 hectares.
Population - Approx. 3,556 people (based on 123.5 people per hectare).
Width of open space between Garden Village and C2 is 150 meters.
